

Highlights of Index of Industrial Production (IIP)
January, 2018 (Base: 2011-12=100)

Growth of Index of Industrial Production (IIP) (Table-1)

Sectoral Industry Groups

- The weightage of Manufacturing, Mining and Electricity production in overall Index of Industrial Production (IIP) is 77.633 per cent, 14.373 per cent and 7.994 per cent respectively.
- The IIP registered a growth of 7.5 per cent in January, 2018 over the Index of January, 2017. IIP growth rate of December, 2017 remains unchanged at 7.1 per cent (Provisional). The growth for Index of Manufacturing, Mining and Electricity was 8.7 per cent, 0.1 per cent and 7.6 per cent respectively during January, 2018.
- IIP registered a Cumulative growth of 4.1 per cent during the period April to January, 2017-18 over corresponding period of previous year. The Index of Manufacturing, Mining and Electricity sector, grew by 4.3 per cent, 2.5 per cent and 5.3 per cent respectively during April to January, 2017-18 over corresponding period of previous year.

Use-based industry groups

- As per the Use-based classification, the Index for Primary goods, Capital goods, Intermediate goods, Infrastructure/construction goods, Consumer durables and Consumer non-durables registered positive growth of 5.8 per cent, 14.6 per cent, 4.9 per cent, 6.8 per cent, 8.0 per cent and 10.5 per cent respectively during January, 2018.
- Cumulatively, for the period April-January, 2017-18, Primary goods, Capital Goods, Intermediate goods, Infrastructure/construction goods and Consumer non-durables registered positive growth of 3.7 per cent, 4.4 per cent, 2.0 per cent, 4.4 per cent and 10.4 per cent respectively while the Index for Consumer Durables registered a decline of 0.3 per cent.

2-digit NIC-2008 industry groups

- 16 industries having weight of 67.60 in IIP (Base: 2011-12) registered increase in production during January, 2018. Details are given below:
